The second time I came with my wife and children we stayed with Daniel and Lori. To our surprise they offered their own bedroom to sleep for a few days. They have made me like their family I love them the way I love myself and my own children, because this is what God has called us to do. To my surprise two years ago I received a text message from Daniel telling me I am his spiritual father. That put me in a very difficult spot because then I have to really show Jesus in my life. I have been asking for the Holy Spirit to help me with this.

Daniel and I have traveled to four countries starting in 2015, Rwanda, Uganda, South Africa & Egypt. During these trips we got to know each other very well, sharing our passion for God and the lost souls. We both love God with our all heart and soul and strive to save a soul at any cost. This shared belief has really brought us closer together.

Last year, 2016, Bill Herron connected with me through a Christian radio show. He has participated in our daily prayer line since 2016.
